

Introducing Oh Lila

The Oh Lila Learning Resource is aimed at children of 3 to 5 years and tells the story of an adventurous young hare called Lila who takes a risk and hurts herself.

Lila experiences a range of emotions before speaking to her friend Eric the squirrel who encourages her to get help from the wise old hare.

The resource is now widely used in nurseries and services working with children and families across Scotland and the UK.

Key findings of our evaluation:


- Practitioners who have been trained were more confident to use the resource
